```
<?
$arr=array();
$arr['name']="John";
$arr['age']=30;
$arr['status']=1;
$keys=array_keys($arr);
print_r($keys);

/* output will be:
p0 = ARRAY
STRING 0 => name
STRING 1 => age
STRING 2 => status
*/
?>
```
