JSON decode a **string** into a **array**

Description

array json_decode (**string** \$data)

Return an **array** containing the JSON array representation of an JSON object (passed as a string).

Parameters

\$data: A **string** to decode

Return Values

JSON decoded **array**

Example

```
<pre><?
    $json_string='{ "a":1,"b":2,"c":3}';
    $res=json_decode($json_string);
    print_r($res);
?></pre>
```

The above example will output:

```
[$res] = Array (
[0] = Array (
    (int) [a] => 1
    (int) [b] => 2
    (int) [c] => 3
)
)
```
